- Doctor and medical specialists and dentist
- Land Transport Authority regarding Drivers Licence and registration of any motor vehicles
- Present and past employers
- Your church group
- Gardening and mailing services
- Cancellation of the newspaper
- Gas and Electricity Department – disconnect if the house will be empty
- New Zealand Post – to have mail redirected
- Telephone service
- Meals on Wheels
- Maybe Schools, college or even the University
- Library
- Sports clubs and organisations you belong to
- Security company if house alarm is monitored
- Sky TV (they require prior notice)
- Neighbourhood Support
- Finance companies if you have any hire purchase
- Registrar of Electors
- Vet
- Shops where you have charge accounts
- Publications you subscribe to
- Police (if you own and store firearms)
